Proposals will be selected using a “best value” methodology based on the following categories.

Price (20 points)	Local business preference applies as defined by Stockton Municipal Code 3.68.090.
Experience and References (20 points)	Contractor’s experience with implementing contracted or grant awarded employment funds. Experience working with government or public agencies. Contractor’s references.
Contractors Program (40 points)	<p>Contractor’s ability to provide a full range of services as defined in the Scope of Work (Section 2.0) and ability to meet Work Hours and Maintenance Schedule (Section 2.6) by current and past experience on like-sized public and/or private projects.</p> <p>Contractor’s proposed Detailed Work Plan (Section 4.5). Described job training resources and proposed training stages.</p> <p>Numbers of participants/employees currently in Contractor’s job training program or similar programs as mentioned in the Scope of Work (Section 2.0).</p> <p>Number of participants/employees who have completed said program; who were once homeless, but now have gained employment and compensation (paid wages).</p> <p>Resources currently provided to participants/employees or referred programs/partners utilized when providing services to individuals in current program.</p>
Organizational Structure (20 points)	Company’s background and qualifications of project team and personnel, including current IRS 501 (c) 3 status, Organizational Chart, listing of Board of Directors and Officers.
