

NOTICE INVITING PROPOSALS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that sealed proposals will be received no later than **Thursday, NOVEMBER 18, 2021, at 2:00 pm (local time)** by the City of Stockton, California for a HOMELESS SYSTEM SUPPORT – PUR 21-032 in strict accordance with the specifications.

The City of Stockton, hereinafter referred to as the “City”, is requesting proposals (RFP) from firms or individuals, hereinafter referred to as “Proponent,” to provide consulting services to the City. As part of the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) of 2021, the City anticipates receiving approximately \$78 million in additional funding to address local needs generated by the COVID-19 pandemic. The portion of funding that is scheduled to award for homelessness and housing initiatives is up to \$12 million. The City currently has \$5 million and anticipates receiving the remaining funds in the June 2022. Because these funds will be received directly from the U.S. Treasury, the City is seeking experienced, professional services to augment staff’s capabilities to ensure compliance with federal regulations while maximizing the recovery and beneficial uses of the ARPA funds in the local community.

The City is undertaking several homelessness initiatives, consisting of demonstration projects, policy analysis and development, collaboration, to produce three (3) major deliverables: 1) project management of demonstration projects; 2) development of departmental homeless policy and program guidelines; and 3) build the foundation for city wide homeless stat process, including appropriate metrics.

Each sealed proposal shall be marked "PROPOSAL" and shall indicate the project name, number, and proposal opening date, and shall be mailed or delivered to the address below at or before the hour stated. Each Proponent must be licensed in accordance with applicable California State Law.

Proposal forms and specifications are available on the City’s website at www.stocktonca.gov/eddbid. Sealed proposals must be delivered to the Office of the City Clerk, City Hall, 425 North El Dorado Street, Stockton, CA 95202 unless electronic mail delivery to city.clerk@stocktonca.gov is applicable. Proponents will only be identified as responding to the RFP; no proposals will be opened or read aloud.

The City reserves the right to reject any/or all proposals received and re-advertise.
