LETTER OF CLARIFICATION NO. 3

WEBER POINT EVENTS CENTER SHADE STRUCTURE REHABILITATION – PHASE 2 PROJECT NO. WP22033

TO ALL PROSPECTIVE BIDDERS

Letter of Clarification No. 3 for the above project consists of the following:

- 1. This acknowledgment form (see important Notice at the end of this document).
- 2. Requests for clarification shall be submitted by 2:00 p.m. on Friday, January 20, 2023. If a request warrants a letter of clarification and sufficient time exists to prepare one, such letter of clarification will be posted on Bid Flash at least two days prior to bid opening.

SPECIFICATIONS:

3. <u>Section 5-1.09 Maintaining Pedestrian Access</u> – **Revise** as follows:

Contractor is not required to maintain the pedestrian access for this project, as Weber Point Event Center will be kept closed to the public during active construction.

4. Section 5-1.12 Schedule – Add after first paragraph as follows:

Contractor must coordinate with City Project Manager regarding the construction start date. Contractor is only allowed to do construction from January 8 to March 31 or September 19 to November 17.

5. <u>Section 5-1.15 Submittals</u> – **Add** following submittals:

- 6. Section 9-1.02 Payments Revise first bullet point of Patterning & Detailing as follows:
 - Preparing fabric template drawings and fabrication details for 84 different fabric panels fabricated into 8 three different subassemblies.

Section 9-1.02 Payments – Add to the first bullet point of Patterning & Detailing as follows:

The eight different panels are depicted on the 'Weber Point Fabric Assembly - Drawing 1000 A' (Exhibit A) from the original 1999 construction. These pattern drawings have been provided for reference. Panels 1, 2, 5, and 6 are shop heat sealed into a single assembly. Panels 3 & 4 comprise a second shop heat-sealed assembly, and Panels 7 & 8 comprise a third shop heat-sealed assembly.

8. <u>Section 9-1.02 Payments</u> - Add paragraph at the end of Patterning & Detailing as follows:

Huntington Design Associates, Inc. will provide Patterning & Detailing Services to the Contractor within six weeks after the execution of the signed Construction Contract between City of Stockton and lowest responsible bidder.

9. <u>Division 5–Steel Cables : Section 1.04B Proofs of Qualification</u>– **Revise** as follows:

Submit with bid evidence satisfactory to Owner that the cable fabricator and cable structure-erector are cable manufacturer is qualified for the work in accordance with Section 1.03B of this specification.

- 10. <u>Division 9-Painting</u>: <u>Section 1.02 Submittals</u> **Add** subsection **D** as follows:
 - D. Proof of Qualification: Submit with bid evidence satisfactory to Owner that the painting applicator is qualified for the Work in accordance with Section 1.03A of this specification.
- 11. Division 13—Tension Membrane Roof : Section 1.03B Revise as follows:
 - B. The Sub-Contractor shall have substantial experience with tensioned fabric structures, including minimum five years documented experience in work of similar scope.
- 12. Division 13–Tension Membrane Roof: Section 1.03C Revise as follows:
 - C. The Sub-Contractor and the Sub-Contractor's personnel who will be actively in charge of the day-to-day activities of the project shall have experience with three or more a minimum three years previous experience with permanent tensioned membrane structures exceeding 600 square meters (6,000 square feet) in plan area. Such experience shall include management of a contract of similar scope, i.e. the supply, fabrication and installation of membrane, membrane connections, associated cables and hardware.
- **13.** <u>Division 13–Tension Membrane Roof</u>: <u>Section 1.06E Proofs of Qualification</u> **Revise** as follows:

E. Proofs of Qualification: Submit evidence satisfactory to the Engineer Owner that the fabric membrane fabricator and installer are qualified for the work in accordance with the requirements of paragraph 4.4 1.03 of this Specification Section. installation of membrane, membrane connections, associated cables and hardware.

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PLANS:

- 14. Sheet S3 General Notes (Structural) Add General Note 9 to Cables as follows:
 - 9. Cable sheathing is required only on new 5/8" diameter "cat-eye" cables, not on existing cables. Sheathing shall be PVC, 90 durometer with UV inhibitors, and shall result in cables with smooth surface and ¾" outside diameter.
