

## **CITY OF STOCKTON – PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS**

### **Project: Columbus Park Renovations**

Q1: Can you clarify the page limit?

A1: Please refer to Section 6.0 Required Proposal Content in the RFP for a page limit.

Q2: Are the restroom facilities prefab or custom?

A2: The restroom facility shall be prefabricated.

Q3: We understand that the proposal content needs to be on 8½ x 11 paper. Can the cost proposal be on 11 x 7 and z-folded?

A3: Yes. Please refer to Section 6.11 Cost Proposal in the RFP for submittal of the cost proposal.

Q4: Can you please clarify how many bound sets you would like us to submit?

A4: Please submit three (3) bound sets and an electronic pdf copy.

Q5: Is there going to be a community outreach component to validate the conceptual plan that was included in the Prop 68 Grant application?

A5: A community outreach phase will not be required.

Q6: Is there a copy of the Grant 68 proposal to review?

A6: A copy of the Grant 68 proposal will be shared with the selected consultant.

Q7: Are there a soils analysis available which were recently conducted? If so, was the soil analysis for structural or agricultural suitability to support horticultural purposes?

A7: Soil analysis is not available.

Q8: An initial concept plan was provided in the RFP announcement. Is the firm that developed it excluded from submitting a proposal for this project?

A8: The request for proposal is open to all qualified consultant to submit a proposal.

Q9: Will specifications be developed in Greenbook, MasterSpec or CSI format, and would the City like us to include ReScape California (Bay-Friendly Landscaping Practices) Specifications into the Special Provisions? Will the City be responsible for generating the front end of the specs?

A9: Specifications shall be developed in MasterSpec format. ReScape California is not required. The City will provide the front-end specs template and the consultant will incorporate them into the technical specifications with minor edits.
