Location: Mariposa Road from Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard/Charter Way to Austin Road in Stockton, CA

Questions & Answers No. 1 – March 30, 2023

Q1: What amount has the City budgeted for the Precise Road Plan?

A1: The estimated budget for the Mariposa Road Precise Road Plan can be found in the City's 2022-2027 Capital Improvement Plan, provided in the link below: https://www.stocktonca.gov/files/2022-2027 Adopted CIP.pdf

Q2: The RFP states that NEPA studies are included in the scope of work. Does this project have federal funding?

A2: Currently, the City does not have any funding sources for design or construction phases. However, it is anticipated that the City will receive some amount of federal funding in the future.

Q3: Our firm does not have an office in Stockton or San Joaquin County. Will we receive points for hiring local subconsultants?

A3: Yes, partial points are given to prime consultants for utilizing local firms, even if the prime is not a local firm.

Questions & Answers No. 2 – April 19, 2023

Q4: Will the Environmental document address both CEQA and NEPA requirements? Who will be the Federal lead agency, and would that agency be directly involved in PRP preparation?

A4: Yes. The City will be the lead agency, and Caltrans approval will be required for NEPA.

Q5: Please confirm if Mariposa Lakes, an approved Project in the General Plan, is expected to be considered during the planning of the PRP. If so, will this be considered under the EPAP scenario? Or only cumulative?

A5: Yes, Mariposa Lakes should be considered. The EIR document is available through the following link:

The scenario considered should be consistent with the 2040 General Plan EIR document.

Q6: Does the City anticipate needing a VMT analysis with the Precise Road Plan, or will VMT be addressed through future projects when the roadway is widened?

A6: Yes, City anticipates VMT analysis will need to be conducted as part of the Precise Road Plan. The Mariposa Road PRP will be in accordance with the 2040 General Plan, so the environmental document can tier off the EIR document from the 2040 General Plan.
