## SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS PLANNED FOR MAIN AND MARKET STREETS Public Meetings for Main Street Complete Streets Project

STOCKTON, Calif. — The City of Stockton will host two open house community meetings to discuss planned safety improvements for Main and Market Streets to create what is known as a Complete Street, making these streets accessible to all modes of travel. The first meeting will be held on April 3, 2024, at the Robert Cabral Station (ACE Train Station), 949 E. Channel St., and the second meeting will be held May 23, 2024, at the Fair Oaks Library, 2370 E. Main Street. Both meetings will be from 5:30 – 7:30 p.m.

The City of Stockton is in the process of completing a plan to reduce vehicle travel lanes, add bicycle lanes, repair sidewalks, and upgrade traffic signals and streetlights. The first phase of the project will improve Main and Market Streets from Downtown Stockton to Wilson Way.
