- 1. Does the City of Stockton have its own Bid Bond Forms?

  Answer: No, the contractor can submit a bid bond on a form provided by the Surety.
- 2. Item No. 23 states that asphalt will be provided by the "City's Asphalt Contract". So you are just looking for a laydown number on the material. The City will provide the asphalt to the site?

Answer: No, per the Special Provision sections 9-1.02, "Payments" shall include transporting asphalt material from the plant to the project site and coordinating with the City's asphalt contract supplier.

- 3. If the City is providing the asphalt, then you will be responsible for any testing of the material at the plant?
  - Answer: Yes, the City is responsible for testing the material at the plant.
- 4. If the contractor is required to transport the asphalt to the site, which plant is the pickup location?

Answer: The contractor will pick up the asphalt at the Granite – Vernalis Plant ( 37400 S Bird Rd, Tracy, CA 95304).

- 5. Where is the Asphalt Plant located so I can calculate the trucking costs? Answer: Please refer to question 4.
- 6. If there are issues with the material not meeting compaction standards, who will be held responsible?

Answer: The City is responsible for testing the material at the plant. If the material placed does not meet compaction requirements is the responsibility of the contractor.

- 7. How many lifts of Tack Coat will be required, 1 or 2?

  Answer: The contractor shall apply tack coat in one application at the minimum residual rate.
- 8. Does the Asphalt Tonnage Quantity include the 1' Wide Patching for all R&R Concrete?

Answer: No, 1' wide asphalt concrete patching is included on each concrete bid item.

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- 9. At Location #2 I do not see the R-65 ramps that are to be replaced. Please advise the exact location of these ramps.
  - Answer: An LOC No. 2 will be issued to include a list of the curb ramp locations and types.
- 10. It is not clear what ramps are to be replaced at location #5. Can you please advise me?
  - Answer: An LOC No. 2 will be issued to include a list of the curb ramp locations and types.
- 11. It is not clear where detail R-66 is located at location #8. Can you please advise me? Answer: An LOC No. 2 will be issued to include a list of the curb ramp locations and types.
- 12. Does the City have dimensions for the ramps?

  Answer: No, there are no dimensions of each ramp.
- 13. The standard drawings show the ramps go from ECR to BCR, but I see other ramps that have been replaced, and they are not replaced from ECR to BCR. They are shorter. If I am figuring to build these ramps from ECR to BCR and they are being built much smaller then I am at a disadvantage. Please advise.

  Answer: The contractor should assume each ramp is constructed from ECR to BCR.
- 14. Locations #5, #6, #8, and #9 have speed bumps. Are these speed bumps supposed to go back in? If so, how will we be paid for these?

  Answer: An LOC No. 2 will be issued to revise the bid form and special provision to include removal and replacement of speed bumps.
