1 I, Kent Autrand, declare:

2 1. I have personal knowledge of the facts set forth in this declaration and, if called
3 as a witness, I could and would testify competently to these facts under oath.

4 2. I was born on March 27, 1950, and am 62 years old. I live at 873 Fox Drive, Fox
5 Island, Washington 98333.

6 3. I was hired by the City of Stockton in August of 1973 and retired in March 2001
7 as a Police Officer.

8 4. My spouse is a dependent on the City's Health Plan. She is 59 years old. We
9 both will be eligible for Medicare when we turn 65.

10 5. My monthly CALPERS retirement check is \$5,853.56. My net annual household
11 income is \$70,242.72.

12 I am informed and believe the City has adopted a monthly premium for retiree health benefits. If
13 required to pay this premium to receive City Health Plan benefits, even with

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
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1 the \$300 per month City subsidy, my premium would be \$1276.66 per month or \$15,319.92
2 annually. That would represent almost 23% of my entire income for the year.

3 7. I am currently taking medications for high blood pressure, high cholesterol, and a
4 thyroid condition. My wife is taking medications and treatments for fibromyalgia, interstitial
5 cystitis, and migraines. These pre-existing conditions will likely prevent our ability to obtain
6 other insurance. Even if we were to find insurance companies that would consider us, the
7 premiums would likely be cost prohibitive.
