1 I, Christine Lumpkin, declare:

2 1. I have personal knowledge of the facts set forth in this declaration and, if called as
3 a witness, I could and would testify competently to these facts under oath.

4 2. I was born on May 23, 1951 and am 62 years old. I live at 1989 Picadilly Way,
5 Manteca, CA 95336.

6 3. I was hired by the City of Stockton in February of 1996 and retired in December
7 of 2009 as an Office Specialist.

8 4. My spouse is my dependent on the City's Health Plan. We both have enough
9 quarters to qualify for Medicare when we reach 65 years of age.

10 5. My CALPERS pension check is \$2485.05. Our taxable income last year
11 including deferred income withdrawn was \$57,862.

12 6. I am informed and believe the City has adopted a monthly premium for retiree
13 health benefits. If required to pay this premium to receive City Health Plan benefits, even with
14 the City's \$150 subsidy, my monthly premium would be \$1426.66 monthly, or 17,119.92

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1 even with the \$300 subsidy from the City for one year, my monthly premium would be
2 \$1,276.66, or \$15,319.92 annually. This represents approximately 26% of our 2011 net annual
3 household income.

4 7. I have Parkinson's and my spouse has chronic kidney dysfunction. We both have
5 high blood pressure and high cholesterol. With our medical history, I am afraid that we will be
6 unable to get health insurance at all, and the City is offering only a very expensive option.

7 I declare under penalty of perjury under the law of the United States of America that the
8 foregoing is true and correct and that this declaration was executed in Stockton, California on
