


# Summer 2019 Repaving Project




The federal Regional Surface Transportation Program has funded the resurfacing of approximately 3 miles of major roadways in Stockton with high traffic volume and poor pavement conditions. Resurfacing will **start in April 2019** and take about three months.

The project includes resurfacing for:

- **Pershing Avenue**, from March Lane to Brookside Road,
- **March Lane**, from Feather River Drive to Riverbrook Drive, and
- **Arch Road**, from B Street to State Highway 99.



## Travel Tips



- Road work will take place between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.
- One lane will be open at all times.
- Watch for changing message signs and workers directing traffic.
- The project is expected to conclude in July 2019.
