### **Stockton Accepting Applications for 49-99 Cooperative Library System Advisory Board**

(Stockton, CA) - The City of Stockton is currently accepting applications to fill one vacancy on the six-member 49-99 Cooperative Library System Advisory Board. The vacancy is due to the term expiration of the City of Stockton's appointed member on September 10, 2010. The term is two years and members are limited to serving two consecutive terms. The term commences upon appointment and ends June 15, 2013. This appointment will be made by the Mayor with City Council concurrence. The deadline for applications is May 31, 2011, 6p.

Qualified applicants must reside in San Joaquin County, but not in the City of Lodi, which has a separate library system, be registered to vote, and not hold any public office or position of employment with the City of Stockton.

The 49-99 Cooperative Library System includes public libraries in Amador, Calaveras, San Joaquin, Stanislaus, and Tuolumne Counties. The California Library Services Act (1978) mandated a citizen advisory board be appointed to assist the

Administrative Council of the 49-99 Cooperative Library System. Each board member represents a public library jurisdiction. The Board's function is to advise the Administrative Council on the need for services and programs, and assist in the evaluation of services provided by the System.

Members serve without remuneration, although certain expenses are allowed. The Advisory Board determines meeting dates and locations and meets up to four times a year, often for one hour in advance of the quarterly Administrative Council meetings. Board members are invited to attend the Administrative Council meetings.
