## **City of Stockton Accepting Applications for Boards & Commissions** ***Central Parking District, Measure A Citizens' Oversight & Port Commission Vacancies***

(Stockton, CA) - The City of Stockton is currently accepting applications for the following Boards and Commissions: Central Parking District Advisory Board, Stockton Measure A Citizens' Oversight Committee and Stockton Port Commission. Applications are available online or from the Office of the City Clerk. Completed applications must be received by the Clerk no later than Friday, January 31, 2014, at 5:00 p.m. Applications received after the deadline will be considered for future recruitments. Applications are valid for one year.

### **Central Parking District Advisory Board**

Applications are being accepted for four (4) positions on the seven (7) member Central Parking District Advisory Board, due to term expirations. This Board serves as an advisory body to the City Council, making recommendations on rules, rates, regulations and development plans of the Central Parking District. Members must own real property or be an executive officer of a corporation that owns real property within the District.

Meetings are the fourth Wednesday of every even month at 1:30 pm in the Central Parking District Office, 123 N. San Joaquin Street. These terms will commence upon appointment and expire June 30, 2018. The full term of office is four (4) years with a

limit of two (2) terms. This is a volunteer position; members receive no remuneration.

**Stockton Measure A Citizens' Oversight Committee**

Applications are currently being accepted for all seven (7) positions on the Measure A Citizens' Oversight Committee. The Mayor and Councilmembers will each nominate one member to the Committee with nominations approved by a majority vote of the full City Council. The Committee will perform the duties set forth in the City of Stockton Transaction and Use Tax Ordinance. The tax was approved by voters in a Special Election on November 5, 2013. Committee duties will include: reviewing and informing the public concerning expenditures of the tax proceeds; presenting an annual written report to the City Council and reporting on progress of implementing the Marshall Plan on Crime and hiring of 120 additional police officers; preparing and presenting a budget recommendation to the City Council each year; and reviewing supporting evidence and findings for the sunset or extension of the sunset of the tax.

Meeting dates and times are to be determined. Committee meetings will be held at City Hall, 425 N. El Dorado Street. Terms of service will be concurrent with the appointing Council Member and limited to two (2) terms. Applicants must be at least 18 years of age and not hold an office incompatible with service on the Committee. The Committee may not include any employee or official of the City or any vendor, contractor or consultant of the City. This is a volunteer position; members receive no remuneration.

**Port Commission**

The City of Stockton is currently accepting applications for one (1) position on the Port Commission to fill a vacancy for an expiring term. The Stockton City Council appoints four (4) members to the seven (7) member Stockton Port Commission. The remaining three (3) members are appointed by the San Joaquin County Board of Supervisors. The Port Commission exercises general supervision over the Port of Stockton by adopting general rules and regulations that best promote the interests of the Port, as established under State law.

Meetings are held the first and third Monday of each month at 3:30 p.m. at the Port District Office, 2201 W. Washington Street, Stockton. The term of office is four (4) years. Members must have resided in the Port District for at least one year prior to appointment. This is a volunteer position; members receive no remuneration.
