Detailed Work Plan (35 points)	Firm's ability to provide professional engineering and environmental consulting services as defined in the Scope of Services (Section 4.0) and ability to effectively assess the project area. Firm's proposed Detailed Work Plan (Section 6.6), including a clearly defined plan for research development and implementation of the prescribed program. Any alternative or additional approaches to the project design. Firm's selected team and their expertise.
Cost Proposal (30 points)	Points will be weighted with regard to the fee most favorable to the City, with all other categories considered first.
Experience and References (25 points)	Experience in providing consulting services for projects similar in scope and size. Firm's references and current/past relationship with the City.
Schedule (5 points)	Effectiveness, clarity and practicality of the schedule provided, describing the time required to complete each task in the scope.
Local Business Preference (5 points)	Local business preference applies as defined by Stockton Municipal Code 3.68.090. A maximum of 5 points will be given for firms with offices in Stockton, and a maximum of 2 points will be given for firms with offices outside of Stockton but within San Joaquin County.
