NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Movant has filed a Motion for Relief from the Automatic Stay in this matter, the details of which are as follows:

That the state actions, Case No. 39-2012-00281432-CU-WM-STK consolidated with Case No. 39-2012-0027995-CU-WM-STK in the Superior Court of California, County of San Joaquin are not those requesting money damages but rather full judicial review as to a disputed meaning of a provision in the City Charter regarding the term limits of the mayor, the election of which will take place on November 6, 2012. Further, Movant alleges that petitioners in this state


1 action are not creditors nor is the action a claim for money as defined in  
2 the Bankruptcy Code.

3 Further, although the City of Stockton has claimed it is protected by the  
4 Stay because it would have to pay attorney's fees or costs to defend the  
5 state action Movant alleges that the payment of attorney's fees involving a  
6 clarification of its own Charter where resident's and voters' Constitutional  
7 rights are involved is not sufficient to justify protection by the Automatic  
8 Stay.

10 Movant, therefore will seek an order from the Bankruptcy Court granting  
11 relief from the Automatic Stay so that the filed state action may further be  
12 pursued to define and protect the rights both of voters and candidates for  
13 office in the City of Stockton in the current and future mayoral races.

15 **FURTHER NOTICE IS GIVEN** that if the City of Stockton fails to file an  
16 objection to the served Motion within 14 days of service the Bankruptcy  
17 Court may issue an order granting the relief sought without further hearing.
