PROCLAMATION OF THE EXISTENCE OF A LOCAL EMERGENCY

The Stockton Municipal Code Section 2.82 empowers the City Manager, as Director of Emergency Services, to proclaim the existence or threatened existence of a local emergency when the City is affected by conditions of disaster or of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property within the City and the Council is not in session.

The City Manager, acting as Director of Emergency Services, does hereby find that:

1. Conditions of disaster and extreme peril to the safety of the persons and property have arisen within the City, caused by uncommon and extreme weather conditions consisting of heavy rainfall and high wind, commencing on or about 12:00 p.m. on the 29th day of December, 2022, which caused flooding and related damage citywide;
2. The City activated its Emergency Operations Center in response to the extreme weather conditions on or about 11:30 a.m on December 31st 2022; and
3. The City Council of the City of Stockton is not in session and cannot immediately be called into session.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY PROCLAIMED AND ORDERED that during the existence of said local emergency the powers, functions, and duties of the emergency organization of this City shall be prescribed by state law, ordinances, and resolutions of this City, and by the City of Stockton Emergency Plan.
