



Special Event Planning **Event Activities**

Activities not included in your permit application are not authorized to take place in your event venue or on City property without permit approval. If activities are not approved within your permit, activities may be terminated by City of Stockton Special event staff. Use of equipment, interactive activities, or animals may require additional safety features, insurance or permits.

Animals

The Stockton Animal Control monitors the use of animals at events. Stockton Animal Control must be permitted full access to examine any/all animals to be used in and/or kept on the premises of your proposed event. Hand sanitizing/wash stations are required at an event and must be available to attendees in instances where animals may be handled by the public. Additional requirements may be required and will be determined at pre-event meeting.

Aquatic Activities

Aquatic activities are allowed at City events with additional conditions. All aquatic activities will be required to submit detailed set up outline and supply additional emergency procedures, insurance and contact all other City departments and/or Sheriff's Department. Additional requirements may be required and will be determined at pre-event meeting.

Car Show

Car show displays are allowed at City events with additional conditions. All cars participating in the event must be notified that vehicles are not allowed to move during the event unless permitted at a Parade. Detailed outline must be submitted providing placement of vehicles. Additional requirements may be required and will be determined at pre-event meeting.

Entertainment

All entertainment such as DJ, Band and any type of performance that will be participating in the event will need to be approved by Community Services Department. Additional requirements may be required and will be determined at pre-event meeting.

Food Vendors

Any food service operation serving or providing food on City property must be approved by the Community Services Department, Stockton Fire Department, City Business License and San Joaquin Health Department. Additional requirements may be required and will be determined at pre-event meeting.

Filming

A filming permit will be required if filming on or within City property. Film permits are processed by the Community Services Department.

Inflatables/Mechanized

The use of inflatables is prohibited in some parks. Examples of inflatables include but are not limited to, jumpers, climbing walls, obstacle courses, décor elements and promotional signage. Approval must be received by Community Services Department to set up on City property.

Sanctioned and Amateur Event

Professional and non-professional events will need to provide the City of Stockton a copy of their contract with the governing body. Event permits will not be approved unless copy of license is provided.
